*It defines the unfair business-to-consumer commercial practices which are prohibited in the European Union. It applies to any act or omission directly related to the promotion, sale or supply of a product by a trader to consumers.*

### *Unfair and blacklisted commercial practices - Your Europe*

*The Unfair Commercial Practices Directive 2005/29/EC regulates unfair business practices in EU law, as part of European consumer law. It requires corresponding laws to be passed that incorporate it into each member state's legal system. The Directive is concerned mainly with the "substantive" law. To some extent it leaves to member states the choice of appropriate domestic enforcement procedures and penalties for non-compliance.*

*When you buy goods and services anywhere in the EU – from a website, a local shop or a seller outside your home country – EU law protects you against unfair commercial practices. When promoting, selling or supplying products, companies must give you enough accurate information to enable you to make an informed buying decision.*
