Prohibition of Female Genital Mutilation (Scotland) Act 2005

5 Commencement and short title. (1) Sections 1 to 4 of this Act shall come into force two months after the date of Royal Assent or on such earlier day as the Scottish Ministers may, by order made by statutory instrument, appoint. (2) This Act may be cited as the Breastfeeding etc. (Scotland) Act 2005.
